

- In accordance with Article 13 paragraph 1 and 2 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) we inform that:

- 1) The entity serving as the Data Controller with regard to your personal data is the company GJC International spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością sp. k with its seat in Poznań, at Podbiałowa 11 Street, 61-680 Poznań, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs kept by the District Court of Poznań – Nowe Miasto and Wilda in Poznań, the 8th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under the National Court Register number 0000636300, Tax Id Number 9721266537;
- 1) in matters related to the protection of personal data, please contact the Data Controller at the following e-mail address: base@gjc.pl;
- 2) Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of providing information about our products and services and about the products and services of our partners. We will process data in the scope of the following types of personal data, i.e. name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number, correspondence data, which were provided by you, based on your voluntary consent, pursuant to Article 6 paragraph 1 letter (a) of the GDPR;
- 3) You have the right to withdraw the previously granted consent for the processing of your personal data at any time. The withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of the data processing which took place on the basis of the granted consent prior to its withdrawal. The consent may be withdrawn by e-mail to the address base@gjc.pl;
- 4) The recipients of your personal data shall be the entities processing the personal data on the basis of a data processing agreement concluded with the Data Controller, if it is necessary to entrust the data for processing, as well as the entities for which the Data Controller provides services. The personal data may be transferred to third countries.
- 5) Your personal data will be stored for a period of time necessary to achieve the objective for which the data was obtained or until the withdrawal of the consent for data processing;
- 6) You have the right to access the content of your data, the right to rectify the data, the right to delete the data, the right to restrict data processing, the right to data portability, the right to object to data processing, and the right to withdraw the consent for the processing of your personal data at any time, which will not affect the lawfulness of the data processing which took place on the basis of the granted consent prior to its withdrawal.
- 7) If you believe that the processing of your personal data constitutes a violation of the General Data Protection Regulation provisions, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- 8) The provision of your data is voluntary, but necessary for the implementation of the objective for which the data was obtained;
- 9) Your data will not be processed in an automated way, including in the form of profiling.
